#### IV. Prize

The best 3 competitors in each category will be awarded medal and Diploma.

The best skater for both Senior Ladies and Senior Men categories will be awarded The Chunichi Cup.

#### V. Music

CDs may be used. All CDs should be handed over on arrival at the Accreditation desk. They should be clearly labeled with Competitor's Name and Club as well as exact playing time of the music (not the skating time) in accordance with Rule 343 paragraph 1.

Music (Short and Free program each) must be recorded on one track on a CD.

All competitors must prepare the back-up CD for the accident.

#### VI. Expenses

<u>The Organizer cannot cover any the expenses</u> of all participants. Each participating National Federation or club must bear all expenses for their skaters, Judges, Team Leaders and Coaches.

(Organizing committee bears the accommodation and meal expenses of judges during the competition period.)

The entry fee is required for all skaters.

Japanese skaters are required 12,000JPY for Senior and Junior, 10,000JPY per skater for all categories. Foreign skaters are required 5,000JPY (approximately 50USD/40 euro) per skater for all categories.

The organizer may prepare the official practice for only skaters who enter Preliminary and 1st classes. Ice time fee is required and paid at the accreditation desk.

#### VII. Official Accommodation

#### OC did NOT decide yet. Please book individually.

Nagano City is the famous sightseeing destination not only Japanese but Foreigners. There are many accommodations in Nagano City, from range of traditional Japanese style Ryokan to Western style International Hotels.

### VIII. Liability

In accordance with Rule 119, the Organizing Committee accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. Each Competitor is expected to provide its own insurance protection. The Organizing Committee will provide emergency medical service for all Competitors during the Competition Period.

#### IX. Judges

Each participating National Federation may nominate one National or International Judge, who will be able to judge one to three categories or more, up to him/her.

In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the panels of judges after the entries closing date. Immediately after, the written confirmation will be sent to each Federation.

Each participating Foreign National Federation or club must pay the judges transportation expense to and from Nagano.

Axel type jump include Waltz jump. (Abbreviation: 1W, SOV:0.3)

The first 1W is only recognized as the Axel type jump.

The next Waltz jump is recognized as "A". (Axel no value). IW can execute only one time.

Downgraded Axel Paulsen is No Value and the Waltz jump and Axel jump is different in nature.

3. All jump elements started in the second half for 1st and preliminary classes are not multiplied by special factor 1.1.
