1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

IWIS International Training Center, together with Figure & Speed Skating Association of Thailand, is pleased to invite you to attend the 2024 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy - Interclub Competition. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2023/2024.

Participation in 2024 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility to Rule 107 number 15 Interclub Competitions.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITIONS:

Advanced Pre-Novice (boys & girls): has reached the age of 7 and has not reached 11 (Born between July 1, 2012 and June 30, 2016)

Advanced Juvenile (boys & girls): has not reached age of 8 (Born on or after 1 July, 2015)





Advanced Pre-Novice - Boys and Girls : Free Skating

A well balanced Free Skating program for Advanced Pre-Novice must contain:

- 1.) Maximum of four (4) jump elements. One of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one jump combination and one jump sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence, the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel Jump. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed.
- 2.) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position. The spin combination with a change of foot must contain a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position with a change of foot must contain a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot must contain a minimum of six (6) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot must contain a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position without change of foot must contain a minimum of six (6) revolutions. In both spins, flying entries are allowed.
- 3.) There must be a maximum of one (1) choreographic sequence.

Levels: in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

Music Duration: 1.50 +/- 10 seconds

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is Boys: 1.67 Girls: 1.67

Fall Deduction : 0.5





Advanced Juvenile - Boys and Girls : Free Skating

A well balanced Free Skating program for Advanced Juvenile must contain:

- 1.) Maximum of three (3) jump elements. There may be up to one (1) jump combination or sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) single jumps, jump sequence can contain only single jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Any jump cannot be executed more than once in total. No double jumps are allowed.
- 2.) Maximum of two (2) spins (minimum of four (4) revolutions). Flying entry is not allowed.
- 3.) There must be a maximum one (1) choreographic sequence. (one must be a forward spiral held for a minimum of three (3) seconds.)

Music Duration: 1.30 +/- 10 seconds

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is

Boys: 1.67

Girls: 1.67

Fall Deduction : 0.5





STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

The draws will take place on May 3, 2024. The schedule will be published after final entry.

3. ENTRIES

Entries of Competitors

- 1. All entries should be made by ISU Members or clubs which are members of National Figure Skating Federations.
- 2. The official entry forms with passport copies must be completed and sent to iwisskating@gmail.com no later than April 3, 2024 20:00 h (local time BANGKOK).

Entries of Team Officials

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff and Coaches must be made using the official form and email to iwisskating@gmail.com

Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one (1) Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

USD 120 - Advanced Juvenile and Advanced Pre-Novice

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

After the final entry by name on Wednesday, April 3, 2024 – 20:00 (local time Bangkok) respective Member Federation will receive an invoice for Entry fee with bank details. Entry fee must be paid on or before April 10, 2024 via bank transfer.





4. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the Referees, Judges, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators beginning dinner Wednesday, May 1, 2024, until breakfast on Friday, May 3, 2024

The travel expenses will be covered only for invited officials.

The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

5. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending separately the music file to iwisskating@gmail.com until April 19, 2024 (two weeks before the event). Any other format is not acceptable.

The title of the file must show the Nation, Competition event, Competitor's name, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.

Example: THA_JuniorWoman_SP_Surname-Name_2:48

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file. CDs will not be accepted. During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and competitors will be allowed the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format_MP3_file).

The Planned Program Content and Music Information must be sent to the OC using the provided official forms no later than April 3, 2024.





If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

6. ACCOMMODATION

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2024 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue of who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

All participants will receive a certificate of participation. The exact time of the Award Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.
