ANNOUNCEMENT



1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 2025 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy in Single Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2024/2025.

Participation in 2025 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

The draws will take place on May 2, 2025. The schedule will be published after final entry.

STARTING ORDER FREE SKATING

In all categories in Free Skating, the starting order will be reversed to the results after the Short Program.

3. ENTRIES

Entries of Team Officials

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff and Coaches must be made via ORS not later than **Tuesday, April 1, 2025 – 20:00**, local time BANGKOK (GMT+7).

Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one (1) Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

5,000 THB - Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice

6,500 THB - Advanced Novice, Junior & Senior

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

4. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the Referees, Judges, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators beginning dinner Thursday, May 1, 2025, until breakfast on Wednesday, May 7, 2025

The **travel expenses** will be covered for invited officials.

The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

5. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending separately the music file to musicfsat@hotmail.com until April 17, 2025 (two weeks before the event). Any other format is not acceptable.

The title of the file must show the Nation, Competition event, Competitor's name, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.



Example: THA_JuniorWoman_SP_Surname-Name_2:48

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file. CDs will not be accepted. During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and competitors will be allowed to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format_MP3_file).

The titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be listed for each Competitor on the dedicated ISU platform.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. Dedicated ISU platform will be - portal.isu.swisstiming.com

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

6. ACCOMMODATION

9. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2025 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue of who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.
