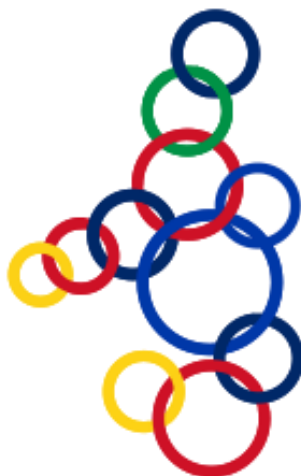

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Short Track Speed Skating Competition at the 2019 SEA Games will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Short Track Speed Skating 2018, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the Short Track Speed Skating Competition at the 2019 SEA Games is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member that is a part of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), and qualify with regard to eligibility according to ISU Rule 102 and the SEA Games Federation (SEAGF) Charter and Rules.

2. DISTANCES

Individual	500, 1000 meters Ladies and Men
Relay	3000 meters Ladies and Men

3. ENTRIES

Each participating NOC entering a Relay Team can only enter a maximum of four (4) Competitors, as well as one (1) Substitute, which will include all competitors for both competitions: Individual and Relay. For Individual Distances, any two (2) of the maximum four (4) skaters entered may skate each distance. All participating competitors must have been born before July 1, 2004.

The final entry by names indicating the names of the skaters in the discipline concerned must be submitted not later than September 30, 2019 by the NOCs to the Organizing Committee, with a copy sent to the Philippine Skating Union (seagames2019.iceskating@gmail.com):

- Names of the Competitors and Substitutes per Category (Men and Ladies)
- Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances
- Confirmation of participation in the Relay

5. TRACK CONDITIONS

The SM Megamall Ice Skating Rink has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2128, or any further update of this Communication. The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

6. ICE TRAINING

All practice sessions will take place at the Competition venue. The Organizing Committee will arrange free official ice training on Monday, December 2, 2019 (15:00 to 19:00) for all participating teams. No other ice training will be provided.

7. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover for the expenses for rooms and meals for all Competitors and Coaches participating, beginning with dinner on December 01, 2019 until breakfast on December 05, 2019.

Should any Competitor or Coach arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual.

8. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

All Referees, Starters, Competitor Stewards, Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff, Competitors and Coaches are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not later than October 15, 2019, the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival. The detailed travel information needs to be submitted via the “**Team Travel Form**” to the Philippine Skating Union (seagames2019.iceskating@gmail.com).

There will be an official shuttle provided between both official hotels and the competition venue during competition days. The detailed transportation schedule will be issued later and communicated to all teams.

10. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the respective official hotels beginning on Wednesday, November 27.

An accreditation card will be issued to all competitors, coaches, team leaders, team medical staff, team officials, and chaperones who are listed in the “Composition of Delegation” form.

Accreditation cards will also be issued to all accredited International Technical Officials (Referees, Starters, and Competitor Stewards).

Competitors will be required to keep their accreditation card with them at all times and be prepared to present them for inspection at the Competition Venue. Only accredited skaters can take part in the official practices and no temporary cards are accepted.

11. MEDAL CEREMONY

The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flags of the medal winners hoisted.

12. MEDICAL SERVICE

A fully equipped medical service area, with one medical doctor and emergency medical technicians will be set up to attend emergencies during the practice and competition. An Ambulance service will be available throughout the official practices and competition proper, if transportation to the hospital is needed.

13. LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each ISU Member participating in ISU Events, as defined in Rule 107, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the ISU Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means.

The ISU assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred by Competitors and Officials.

14. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications No. 2213 & 2243 or later updates).
