Bangkok 2026 International Short Track Development Camp & Competition

27 July - 2 Aug 2026

At IWIS International Training Center, Thailand

Get ready for an intensive and exciting week dedicated to developing short track speed skating athletes through high-quality training and international competition exposure. This comprehensive program is designed to elevate athletes' technical abilities, race strategies, and overall performance readiness in a structured and supportive environment.

The camp will be led by **Coach Hongyang Wang** (USA Olympic Team Coach), in collaboration with Thailand National Team coaches **Junghyun An** and **Taehyun Choi**, former Korea National Team coaches for the Winter Olympic Games. The coaching team will be joined by **Andrew Heo** (USA), a two-time Olympian and the 2025 ISU World Tour Gold Medalist, who will share his elite-level experience and provide on-ice demonstrations throughout the camp.

The program will consist of:

- **5 days of on-ice and off-ice training**, followed by
- **2 days of competition**, serving as a practical “final exam” for all participants

Participants can expect high-level technical instruction, race simulation, performance analysis, and interactive coaching designed to improve both physical and mental aspects of competition.

Participation

We warmly welcome skaters and coaches, with a primary focus on participants from Southeast Asia and Oceania.

Capacity: 80 skaters

- Skaters will be divided into groups according to their age and skill level
- Each participating team should be accompanied by their own coach
- Coaches will actively assist and collaborate during the camp

To further enhance the competitive environment, the competition will also be open to external skaters who are not attending the training camp.

Quota: Up to 10 skaters per country. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional quota allocations may be considered subject to overall camp capacity availability.

Deadline: 26 June 2026, 12 pm, BKK time.

Minimum age requirement: 8 years old (as of 1 July 2026)

Participation Fee

800 USD per skater, including:

- Training camp fee
- Competition fee
- Accommodation (2 persons/room from 26 July - 3 Aug 2026)
- Full-board meals (starting from breakfast 27 Jul 2026 to breakfast 3 Aug 2026)
- Local transfers

Accommodation

Participants will stay in designated accommodation arranged by the Organizing Committee, twin sharing room. Single-room upgrades may be available at additional cost, subject to availability.
