Participation Criteria

Each federation may send up to six (6) coach/skater partnerships

Skaters:

- Up to **six** skaters per country, accompanied by their own coach.
- Must have reached the age of at least 10 yrs. by 1st May 2026 Skaters may only participate with their coach.
- Skaters selected by the ISU Member should have shown a significant improvement in their skill level in the last twelve months.
- Skater should be in Novice, Junior and Senior categories

Skill level guidelines for skaters:

The **minimum skill level** for any skater joining the seminar with their coach:

- Skaters should be able to execute all double jumps and are working on the double axel.
- Skaters should be able to execute three spinning positions on both feet. (Upright, Camel and Sit positions)
- Skaters should be able to execute all difficult turns and step on both feet (Twizzles, Bracket, Counter, Rocker, Loop and Choctaw)

Coaches:

- Up to **six** coaches per country, each of whom will accompany their own participating skater(s).
- Coaches must be interested in and able to contribute to the material in accordance with the goal of the project.
- English will be the language used throughout the seminar.
- The coaches should be committed to developing their coaching skills and who have skaters that fall into the categories above.
- The coaches should have experience in coaching international level skater/s.

Federations select their own participants according to the participation criteria of the project. After the payment deadline, any available places will be filled by agreement between the participating countries and the organizing team.
